# **TOURNAMENT RULES**

All Players must hole out and mark score cards

- 1. Championship Flight will play the Deck 1 tees
- 2. All Other Flights will play the Deck 2 tees
- 3. Ladies will play the Deck 4 tees
- 4. First 9 holes are match play, 1 plays 2, 3 plays 4 on score card both A & B sides.
- After 9 holes the 4 winners of the A & B side play and the 4 losers of the A & B side play. Next 9 holes are stroke play.
- 6. All ties will be broken by chip off at green of your final hole.
- 7. Out of Bounds Rules are indicated on your score cards.
- On all Par 4 & 5 Holes, lost balls or out of bounds off the tee box, go to drop flag. Penalty 2 strokes. (e.g. Shooting 4)
- **9.** On all Par 3 Holes, lost ball or out of bounds off the tee box, go to drop flag. Penalty 1 stroke. (e.g. Shooting 3)
- **10.** Maximum three minutes time looking for lost ball.
- **11.** Team Captains/Scorecard holders must complete score cards at completion of round and turn into committee members at the golf course.

# **HOLE-IN-ONE RULES**

- **1.** First in on the designated hole will be the winner.
- **2.** All shots must be made in the regular round of play in the tournament by a registered participant with no practice shots permitted.
- **3.** The participants must complete all score cards.
- **4.** A course marshal or adjudicator must be stationed and monitoring play at the selected hole at all times during the tournament.
- **5.** In the case of a hole-in-one, certification of achievement must be made on the score card of the participant achieving the hole-in-one by the course marshal and all participants within the group in which the hole-in-one was made.
- **6.** The tournament must be played in groups of three or four. *No twosomes allowed.*
- **7.** A ball hit out of bounds or replayed for any reason does not qualify as a hole-in-one. This would constitute as a hole-in three.
